When you have players of the standard that they have, if they want it enough, they will always get a result. It is difficult to stop them. This is something that we have not seen in England for a while. I like teams that want it and want to win. They have not won for seven years and they wanted to win on Sunday, but they did not want to do it. It is not the style of English football, it is not the attitude and it is not the way it is managed. You cannot win a major tournament playing with an open front door, as you did at Anfield. It will be the same in the World Cup if they go back to their country. Look at Germany against Greece, the number of games
